

CTA Examination Fees and How to Pay

The written and oral parts of the CTA examination are paid for separately. Please check the information below to ensure that your payment is made to the correct organisation.

Written examination – paid to UKATA

UKATA administers the written examination for UK candidates under its own national arrangement.

Current fees are:

CTA Written Examination	£375
Resubmission of the CTA Written Examination	£250

Oral examination – paid to EATA

Once you have passed the written examination, you will apply to EATA for the oral examination.

The current oral examination fee for UKATA candidates is €180. The fee is paid directly to EATA, following the payment instructions provided through EATA's English Language Examination Coordinator, when you submit your oral examination application and Principal Supervisor's Endorsement.

The English Language Examination Coordinator is an EATA role and is your point of [contact](#) for the oral examination process.

You may see a total fee of €360 in EATA's information. As UKATA candidates pay UKATA separately for their written examination, they pay EATA only the applicable oral examination fee.

Please check EATA's [current examination fees and payment details](#) and confirm the arrangements with the English Language Examination Coordinator before making payment.
